What ONE Nation stands for...

Enshrined in the One Nation Western Australian Party Constitution is the duty of elected politicians to represent their electorate. Where there is conflict between the party and the electorate the electorate shall take precedence.

- The support of fair and equal treatment of all Australians within a system of government recognising and acting upon the need for Australia to be truly **One Nation**.
- To ensure that all Australian citizens have the freedom to express their opinions without fear and to fully participate in all aspects of democracy.
- To support and advocate traditional family values, to uphold the institution of the family as the foundation of a decent and moral society and to enshrine in legislation: That the natural family is the

fundamental human community, based on the union of a man and a woman, in which new individuals are conceived, born and raised.

- To abolish positive discrimination and affirmative action, to contain political correctness and to ensure that the rights of all Australians are one and the same.
- To ensure our society remains benevolent in its approach to citizens in need who cannot provide for themselves and to offer government assistance equally to all Australians
- To protect Australian sovereignty, preserve our flag and to educate our children in the unabridged history of our country.
- To educate our young to established internationally acceptable standards and enable them to have the opportunity to successfully take their place in society.
- To honour the memory of those who gave their lives in defence our country and to generously support and remunerate those who risk their lives in our defence force.
- To establish national service in the form of military or civilian service for all Australians of appropriate age.
- To ensure that law abiding Australians will have access to firearms to undertake legitimate activities within the law.
- To legislate to ensure the safety of the Australian people.
- To ensure those convicted of crimes endure appropriate penalties and are dealt with justly and expediently.
- To actively pursue and promote agreements and treaties, investment and development as deemed appropriate and in the national interest
- To repeal all international agreements and UN treaties that does not benefit the people of Australia and to submit all future treaties and agreements to public scrutiny and both houses of parliament for approval.
- To restrict foreign ownership of Australian assets and domestic housing and to reclaim and put an end to the privatisation of all public utilities.
- To control immigration in accordance with both social and infrastructure requirements and in compliance with the wishes of the Australian people.
- To ensure all those entering Australia are subject to stringent health checks and appropriate restraints are exercised upon those suffering from contagious deceases.
- To reform taxation to ensure all companies and individuals pay appropriate tax with increased support for the needy and fewer escape clauses for the greedy.
- To financially support by tax exemption - or other means - Australian manufacturing and industry and to financially support the rural sector in a manner similar to the United States and the EU.
- To establish an Australian government owned National Bank to support national infrastructure, fee free superannuation, and for the purpose of offering low interest loans for housing, the rural sector and Australian owned manufacturers and industry.

- To establish a minimum carbon tax the proceeds of which will be quarantined for research into renewable energy, to make it unlawful to purchase carbon credits for the purpose of allowing the increase of, or the deliberate maintenance of carbon emissions.
- To prevent the export of Australian native timbers.
- To secure the election to public office of members committed to the above objectives
