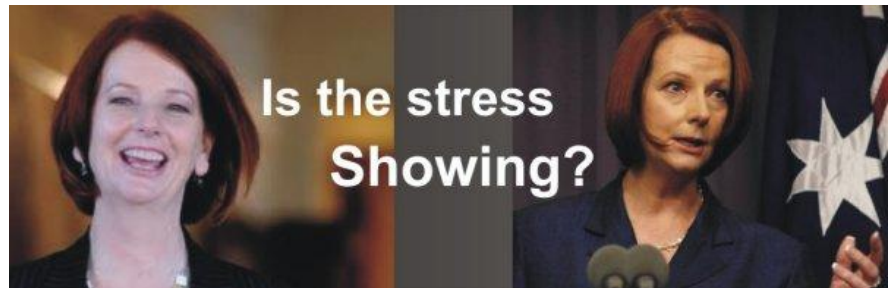


Gillard on The Ropes!
